ORDINANCE NO. 1 OF 2014

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 133 OF THE CODE OF WILLISTOWN TOWNSHIP REDUCING SPEED LIMITS TO 25 MPH FOR DUFFRYN AVENUE AND GARRETT MILL ROAD, ESTABLISHING 25 MPH SPEED LIMITS FOR BARR ROAD, FOX CHASE ROAD AND RAMBLING LANE AND ESTABLISHING A MULTI-WAY STOP INTERSECTION AT CEDAR HOLLOW ROAD AND GABLE ROAD. EFFECTIVE FIVE DAYS FROM ENACTMENT.

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Willistown Township, Chester County, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 133, §133-7 of the Code of Willistown Township (the “Code”) is amended by reducing the speed limits for Duffryn Avenue and Garrett Mill Road to 25 mph and establishing 25 mph speed limits for Barr Road, Fox Chase Road and Rambling Lane as follows:

Name of Street	Speed limit (mph)	Location
Barr Road	25	Entire Length
Duffryn Avenue (T510A)	25	Between King Road (T606) and Third Avenue (T510B)
Fox Chase Road	25	Between Hillview Road and Whitehorse Road
Garrett Mill Road	25	Between West Chester Pike and Goshen Road
Rambling Lane	25	Between Paoli Pike and Clearview Road

Section 2. Chapter 133 of the Code is amended to add a new §133-10A to read as follows:

§133-10A. Stop intersections.

The following intersections are stop intersections, and official stop signs shall be erected in such a position as to face traffic to be controlled as listed in the “Controlling Traffic” column. All


motor vehicles approaching any such intersection as traffic to be controlled shall come to a full stop within a reasonable distance before entering any such intersection:

Intersection	Controlling Traffic
Cedar Hollow Road and Gable Road	3-way stop

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective five days from the date of enactment.


