ORDINANCE NO. 2 OF 2014

**AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 1601(C.1)(2) AND 2203(B)
OF THE SECOND CLASS TOWNSHIP CODE, AMENDING SECTION
96-5 OF THE WILLISTOWN TOWNSHIP CODE OF ORDINANCES TO
PROVIDE FOR ENFORCEMENT OF PARK REGULATIONS.
EFFECTIVE FIVE DAYS FROM ENACTMENT.**

The Board of Supervisors of Willistown Township hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

Section 1. The Willistown Township Code of Ordinances, Chapter 95, relating to Parks, Section 96-5, Violations and penalties, is amended to read as follows:

- A. Pursuant to Section 1601(c.1)(2) of the Second Class Township Code, any person who violates this chapter, and/or any regulation established herein, shall, by action brought before a District Magistrate Judge in the same manner provided for the enforcement of summary offenses under the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure, upon judgment of conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding \$1,000 per violation, together with the costs of prosecution; and further subject to imprisonment to the extent allowed by law for the punishment of summary offenses. Each day a violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.
- B. Parents and/or legal guardians of person(s) less than 18 years of age will be held liable for any/all fines assessed and/or damages incurred by those persons to Township park properties.
- C. Further, the appropriate officers or agents of the Township are hereby authorized to seek any other available relief at law or equity, including injunction, to enforce compliance with this chapter.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days from the date of enactment.
