The Regular Meeting of the Willistown Township Board of Supervisors came to order at 7:00 PM. Supervisors Robert T. Lange, and Barbara L. Handelin were present. Also present were Interim Township Manager, Daniel E. Malloy, Chief of Police, John M. Narcise, and Police Lieutenant, Robert P. Klinger.

Supervisor Lange led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag and a moment of silence for military personnel.

Announcements

Supervisor Lange announced that the Board of Supervisors met in Executive Session on June 10, 2019 to discuss personnel and legal issues.

New Business

Supervisor Handelin moved to appoint Sally A. Slook as Township Manger, Supervisor Lange seconded. After brief comments the motion carried by a vote of 2-0. Judge Tartaglio administered the Oath of Office.

Supervisor Handelin moved to approve the list of expenditures and interfund transfers dated June 10, 2019. Supervisor Lange seconded the motion. There were no comments from the Board or the public, and the motion carried by a vote of 2-0.

Citizen Comments

A citizen asked if the Supervisors had any information on the Paoli Pike project. Dan Malloy stated that Peco will be starting the gas project on Friday, June 14th and ending the following Friday, June 21st. They will be working around the clock. The shoulder will remain open for police and ambulance. It is not wide enough for fire trucks and the fire companies are aware of this. They will be tunneling underneath the road and there will be a permanent restoration. The road closure is 1.4 miles.


Next Meeting
