**** 57 Grubb Rd., parcel 54- 1P - 174 – page 70 in Acres of Quakers, Green Tree school, subdivision.**

Jamie Jun, attorney, presented the client’s request for subdivision approval. The historic commission recommends subdivision approval if the side setback of lot #2 can be increased to provide a greater buffer to the historic resource on lot #1.

**** 7043 Goshen Rd., parcels 54-6-87 and 54-6-88, pages 244 and 299 in Acres of Quakers, proposed lot line change.**

Erik Hetzel from WCT presented the request. The historic commission recommends approval of the lot line change.

**** Township historical structure definition, new resource candidates:**

A. Radnor Hunt. Warren Claytor was not present, no progress reported.

B. 8085 Goshen Rd. No progress reported, but Mimi and Terry have sent another letter to the owner.

C. Nike battery site, Delchester Road and West Chester pike. Terry will reach out to Jane Dorchester for clarification as to whether or not this site is an accessory resource in the Okehocking Historic District and if the district can be revised to include the Nike Site as a contributing resource.

**** Architectural elements salvage and reuse.**

Greg Prichard will give Ed Tiernan the Lower Merion salvage information form to add to the Willistown permit application packet.

**** Certified Local Government Program.**

Terry Kile will coordinate the certified local government certification program with Sally Slook and others in the Township government to facilitate getting Willistown Township officially certified.
