

**WILLISTOWN TOWNSHIP RECYCLING COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

The regular meeting of the Willistown Township Recycling Commission came to order at 7:01 pm.

Old Business

- Minutes from January, 2020 meeting were approved
- 902 Grant: Susan reported that we qualify for the grant (which can be as much as \$350,000) since we were not awarded last year and we are not applying this year. The Commission members discussed some project ideas for next year (application due March 2021). Ideas included adding composting, either via haulers or a drop off location in the Township. Or, home composting could be promoted and facilitated. Bruce will talk to Tredyffrin about their composting program, Molly to reach out to Lanchester landfill, and Susan will talk to Mary Alice Reisse of the DEP to get more information about composting. Susan also suggested an educational speaker series to be funded by the grant.
- Molly received a response from Jennifer Jacobs regarding her inquiry about expanding the scope of the Recycling Commission. Jennifer provided some history and background and directed us to other resources including the township code, the Environmental Advisory Council, and some of the larger townships, such as Tredyffrin, that may have larger environmental programs.

New Business

- Recycling event dates were confirmed for Spring, 2020. They are:
 - Chipping: April 4
 - E-Waste: April 25
 - Shredding: May 16All events will be 9am-noon.
- There was no constituent correspondence during the past month.
