Supervisor Shoemaker amended the motion to include Newtown Square Fire Company. Supervisor Lange seconded the motion. There were no comments from the Board or the public, and the motion carried 3-0. Supervisor Shoemaker asked Township Administration to stay in contact with the four fire companies to make sure their needs are covered.
