The "1883 foundation" was formed at Radnor Hunt to preserve all historic resources at the club - 2 old houses, the barn, and the red clay courts.

### **Certified local government.**

According to Cory Kegerise we need to rewrite our definition of an historic resource to qualify as a "certified local government," to obtain funding from the state. Bart Van Valkenburgh, Greg Prichard and Bob Smiley are going to work on this project, to present an updated Historic preservation ordinance to the Planning commission for approval.
