

Willistown Township Historical Commission
Meeting Minutes
July 5, 2022, 7:00PM
688 Sugartown Rd., Malvern, PA

The meeting was called to order at 7:00PM with the Pledge of Allegiance by Chairman Bart Van Vaulkenburgh. In attendance in addition to the Chairman were Dave Hopkins, Greg Prichard, Mimi Quinn-Johnson, Sharon Sukonick, Jody Vandergrift and attending for Bob Smiley, Mary Hundt.

The Minutes of the June 7, 2022 Meeting were approved.

- 1) The first presenter was Alyssa Novak of Archer Buchanan Architecture, West Chester with a plan of modification and proposed addition to 333 S. Valley Rd., the John Wilson House AofQ Page 593. Greg Prichard made the motion to accept the plan, Mimi Quinn-Johnson seconded it and it was approved unanimously.
- 2) The next presentation was by Nathan Jameson, owner of 8 Barr Rd for modifications to a barn at White Horse Farm, AofQ pg. 358. Mr Jameson showed photographs and renderings of proposed changes to the exterior of the barn. There was much discussion about the proposed features. The Commission asked that Mr Jameson make some revisions to his plan and return to present again to the Commission at the August Meeting.
- 3) Willistown Township Tour to be held June 7, 2022 at the Radnor Hunt Club on Providence Rd., Malvern. Bart reviewed the details of the tour which would include three buses conducting three tours each of the historic sites in the township. He explained that there would be tables for the members to man to offer information to the visitors as well as tables in the 1883 house that would be staffed by members of the 1883 Foundation, The Willistown Conservation Trust, The Hounds Foundation and Historic Sugartown with information about each of the groups. There was also a cash bar for refreshments.
