

## **DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the winter storm of February 4 and February 5, 2014 caused damage and suffering to the persons and property of Willistown Township; and

WHEREAS, another significant winter storm is forecast for the overnight hours of February 12 and February 13, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the storms have endangered the health, safety and welfare of a substantial number of persons residing in Willistown Township and threaten to create problems greater in scope than Willistown Township may be able to resolve; and

WHEREAS, emergency management measures are required to reduce the severity of these disasters and to protect the health, safety and welfare of affected residents in Willistown Township;

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the undersigned Supervisors of Willistown Township pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, (35 PA C.S., Section 7501), as amended, do hereby declare the existence of a disaster emergency in Willistown Township;


FURTHER, we direct the Willistown Township Emergency Management Coordinator to coordinate the activities of the emergency response, to take all appropriate actions needed to alleviate the effects of this disaster, to aid in the restoration of essential public services, and to take any other emergency response actions deemed necessary to respond to this emergency.

STILL FURTHER, we authorize officials of Willistown Township to act as necessary to meet the current exigencies of this emergency, namely: by the employment of temporary workers, by the rental of equipment, by the purchase of supplies and materials, and by entering into such contracts and agreements for the performance of public work as may be required to meet the emergency, all without regard to those time-consuming procedures and formalities normally prescribed by law, mandatory constitutional requirements excepted.

This Declaration shall take effect at 12:01 AM, Wednesday, February 12, 2014.
