Agricultural Security Area: Application of the Willistown Conservation Trust

The applicant was represented by John Mezzanotte, Esq... He explained the plan to have 39 acres of the Rushton Woods Preserve be made an Agricultural Preserve and that the criteria had been met for use, soils, zoning and agricultural viability.
