

**WILLISTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING MINUTES**  
**688 SUGARTOWN ROAD, MALVERN, PA**  
**OCTOBER 23, 2017 AT 7:00 PM**

The regular meeting of the Willistown Township Board of Supervisors came to order at 7:00 PM. Supervisors William R. Shoemaker, George J. McHugh, IV, and Robert T. Lange were present. Also present were Treasurer Martin F. McKenzie and Officer Robert Will.

Martin F. McKenzie led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag, followed by a moment of silence for our troops.

**Announcements**

The Board met in Executive Session immediately following the Regular Meeting on October 9, 2017 to discuss litigation and personnel matters.

**Special Presentations**

Representatives of the Malvern Library and Paoli Library attended the meeting to provide an update to the Board. Maggie Stanton, the new Library Director in Malvern, reported on circulation for 2016, indicating a new direction for 2017. Beverly Michaels, Branch Director in Paoli, provided a handout with statistical information on volunteers, circulation, and program utilization. Both Libraries reported on another successful year with Willistown's GoWilma! Program.

**New Business**

Mr. Lange moved to approve the Board of Supervisors meeting minutes dated October 9, 2017. Mr. McHugh seconded the motion. There were no comments from the Board or the public and the motion passed unanimously.

Mr. McHugh moved to approve the List of Disbursements and Interfund Transfers dated October 23, 2017. Mr. Lange seconded the motion. There were no comments from the Board or the public, and the motion carried unanimously.

**Police Report**

Officer Will reported that the Police Department is working to address concerns at the intersection of Grubb Road and Third Avenue. In addition, the Department is working with PennDOT to address safety concerns at the intersection of Dutton Mill Road and West Chester Pike.

**Citizens' Comments**

Mahala Renkey of Tulip Drive inquired about the Township's handling of the use of lights on the property owned by the Greater Chester Valley Soccer Association. Mr. Shoemaker indicated that the Township was pursuing the matter vigorously. Any future incidents should be reported via email to Mr. Burman and the Police Department.

**Next Meeting**


The next regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors will be held on Monday, November 13, 2017 at 7:00 PM at 688 Sugartown Road.
