

WILLISTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING MINUTES
688 SUGARTOWN ROAD, MALVERN, PA
MONDAY, NOVEMBER 19, 2018 AT 7:00 PM

The Regular Meeting of the Willistown Township Board of Supervisors came to order at 7:00 PM. Supervisors Robert T. Lange, William R. Shoemaker, and Barbara L. Handelin were present. Also present were Township Manager David R. Burman, Police Lieutenant Robert P. Klinger, and Detective Sergeant Jeffrey S. Heim.

Supervisor Lange led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag and a moment of silence for military personnel, as well as those who have been affected by the wildfires in California.

Announcements

Supervisor Lange announced the following:

Willistown Township Parks & Recreation will host an informational meeting concerning the Spotted Lanternfly. The meeting is scheduled for Thursday, November 29, 2018 at 7 PM at General Wayne Elementary School Auditorium. The speaker will be Michael E. Panuschka, a Forester with the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture, Bureau of Plant Industry, Entomology Division. Topics will include: General information about the Spotted Lanternfly; identification; what pest management homeowners, landscapers, property managers, and municipal employees can undertake throughout the year; Tree of Heaven management; and the Willistown Parks Spotted Lanternfly Program.

New Business

The Board tabled consideration of the minutes of the meeting held November 7, 2018.

Supervisor Shoemaker moved to approve the list of expenditures and interfund transfers dated November 19, 2018. Supervisor Handelin seconded the motion. There were no comments from the Board or the public, and the motion carried by a vote of 3-0.

Supervisor Shoemaker moved to advertise the Proposed 2019 Operating and Capital Budget. Supervisor Handelin seconded the motion and asked Mr. Burman for a brief overview. Mr. Burman provided some background information and reported that the proposed budget document would include much more detail than in prior years and the entire document would be available on the Township website within the next week. Mike Kerr of 33 Stonehenge Lane commented on the budget. There were no comments from the Board or the public, and the motion carried by a vote of 3-0.

Police Report

Lieutenant Klinger reported on recent activities of the Police Department, including the investigation into a serious accident on Sugartown Road near the Charles E. Coxe Memorial Campus. In addition, Lieutenant Klinger thanked the road crew for the tremendous work clearing the roads during the recent winter weather. The Board of Supervisors and several residents expressed appreciation to the road crew for a job well done.

Citizens' Comments

Fred Hack of King Road inquired about the plowing of an HOA near his home. Mr. Burman was asked to contact the management company.
